EHW were appointed in February 2012 by Bowmer & Kirkland Building Services (BKBS) of Derby to provide architectural services for the construction of their mixed use redevelopment of the former James Taylor site in Collent Street, Hackney London E9.

The scheme comprises partial demolition of the existing building, including the retention of an existing facade, formation of a new basement car park, ground floor office accommodation and ten storeys of 1, 2 and 4 bed residential units providing a total of 69 apartments including 23 Housing Association units.

The construction took two years to complete with the final contract being valued at approximately £8.5m.
